The Lord said to Elijah: "Go, you are to anoint Elisha, son of Shaphat of Abel Meholah, as prophet to succeed you." Leaving there, Elijah came on Elisha, son of Shaphat as he was plowing behind twelve yoke of oxen; he himself being with the twelfth. Elijah passed near to him and threw his cloak over him. Elisha left his oxen and ran after Elijah, "Let me kiss my father and mother, then I will follow you," he said. Elijah answered, "Go, go back; for have I done anything to you?" Second Reading: Galatians 5:1, 13-18.

When Christ freed us, he meant us to remain free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery. My brothers, you were called, as you know, to liberty; but be careful, or this liberty will provide an opening for self indulgence. Serve one another, rather, in works of love, since the whole of the Law is summarised in a single command: Love your neighbour as yourself. If you go snapping at each other and tearing each other to pieces, you had better watch or you will destroy the whole community. Let me put it like this: if you are guided by the Spirit you will be in no danger of yielding to self-indulgence, since self-indulgence is the opposite of the Spirit, the Spirit is totally

against such a thing, and it is precisely because the two are so opposed that you do not always carry out your good intentions. If you are led by the Spirit, no law can touch you.

PRAYER NEEDS GRACE

Old Testament Prophets such as Elisha and Elijah were sent by God to teach His people. Today's teachers are the Bishops of the Church. Also, every home, as a domestic Church, has its own in-built teachers, they are parents. We are obliged to obey them. One should not make excuses for not being compliant. Parents are the best teachers of their children in the ways of Faith. God's will, however, overrides parental obligation.



Jesus said: "But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." When actual graces are given God expects us to act, and to use those graces. Many souls desire to do God's will but they lack commitment and are filled with excuses.

Our Way to Jersusalem

On our pilgrim way, we encounter three obstacles: the world, the flesh and the devil (1 John 2:15-18).

World: opposition that comes from others who are strangers to God and his providential care;

Flesh: our creature comforts and lifestyle that is habitually in grained;

Devil: temptations that prevent us from responding to God's will here and now.

■ **What is Actual Grace?**

Grace is divided into two broad categories sanctifying grace and actual grace. The Catechism of

the Church [CCC 2000] says that Sanctifying grace is an habitual gift, a stable and supernatural disposition that perfects the soul itself to enable it to live with God, to act by his love. Without this grace in our soul at death we cannot be saved. Actual grace, however, refers to God's interventions, whether at the beginning of conversion or in the course of the work of sanctification. We are in need of grace to help us grasp the truths of faith, to guide our steps, which inspire godly thoughts that result in godly actions.

St Maria Goretti

(1890-1902) was the third of seven children of a poor family in Italy who shared a house with another family who had two sons, one was Alessandro. Maria's father died when she was ten. Alessandro was besotted with Maria's beauty and sought to seduce her. When she refused, in blind rage, he stabbed her fourteen times. Before her death a day later, she forgave him. He was sentenced to thirty years in jail, and for the first seven was unrepentant and bitter. After Maria appeared to him in a dream, he changed and was a model prisoner for twenty years. Maria was canonized in 1950. Alessandro died in 1970 after entering a monastery.
