First Reading: Samuel 3:3-10

Samuel was lying in the sanctuary of the Lord, where the ark of God was, when the Lord called, 'Samuel! Samuel!' He answered, 'Here I am.' Then he ran to Eli and said, 'Here I am, since you called me.' Eli said, 'I did not call. Go back and lie down.' So he went and lay down. Once again the Lord called, 'Samuel! Samuel!' Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, 'Here I am, since you called me.' He replied, 'I did not call you, my son; go back and lie down.' Samuel had as yet no knowledge of the Lord and the word of the Lord had no yet been revealed to him. Once again the Lord called, the third time. He got up and went to Eli and said, 'Here I am, since you called me.' Eli then understood that it was the Lord who was calling the boy, and he said to Samuel, 'Go and lie down, and if someone calls say, "Speak, Lord, your servant is listening."' Second Reading: 1st Corinthians 6:13-20

The body is not meant for fornication: it is for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. God, who raised the Lord from the dead, will by his power raise us up too. You know, surely, that your bodies are members making up the body of Christ; do you think I can take parts of Christ's body and join them to the body of a prostitute? Never! But anyone who is joined to the Lord is one spirit with him. Keep away from fornication. All the other sins are committed

outside the body; but to fornicate is to sin against your own body. Your body, you know, is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you since you received him from God. You are not your own property; you have been bought and paid for. That is why you should use your body for the glory of God.

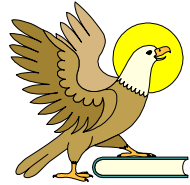

The word *Gospel* - glad tidings - comes from the Greek word *evangelion*, and the writer of the Gospel is called an Evangelist.

■ **What is fornication?**

CCC 2353: Fornication is a carnal union between an unmarried man and an unmarried woman.

■ **Is fornication sinful?**

CCC 1852: There are a great many kinds of sins. Scripture provides several lists of them. The Letter to the Galatians contrasts the works of the flesh with the fruit of the Spirit: "Now the works of the flesh are plain: **fornication**, impurity... and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things shall not inherit the Kingdom of God" (Gal. 5:19).

■ **Is sin in the heart?** CCC 1853: The root of sin is in the heart of man, in his free will, according to the teaching of the Lord: "For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murder, adultery, **fornication**, theft, false witness, slander. These are what defile a man." (Mat 15:19).

Optimist: you refuse the parachute because people have survived crashes just like this before.

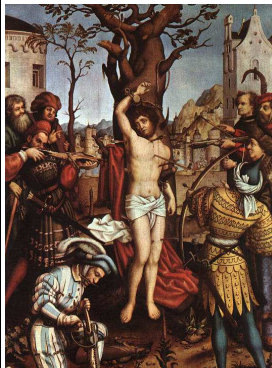
Procrastinator: you play a game of Monopoly for the parachute.
