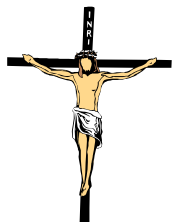

Christ the King



Pope Pius XI instituted the feast of Christ the King when Christ was being pushed more and more out of the lives of nations, families and individuals. The Pope commented that when the reign of Christ was challenged by secularism, it was opportune to institute a feast of the kingship of Christ. We recall that Pilate once said to Christ: 'Art thou a king then?' Jesus answered: *"I am a king. For this was I born, and for this came I into the world, that I should give testimony to the truth."*



INRI on top of Jesus' cross refers to His sentence.

Q. In what languages was it written ?

Answer: John 19:20

INRI on top of Jesus' cross on Calvary is the Latin abbreviation of His sentence which means

- I = **Jesus** (I is the same as J in Latin)
- N = **Nazareus**
- R = **Rex - King**
- I = **Judaeorum - of the Jews**

- King of kings = Jesus Christ
- Kingdom = Church - in heaven
- Reign = power of divine grace in the heart
- Royal Subjects = baptized members
- Queen Mother = Mother of God

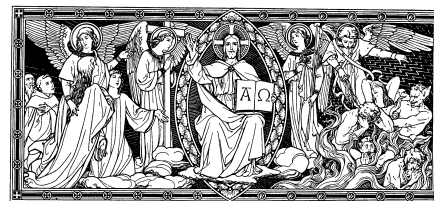
The kingship or reign of Christ is His grace based on truth, for Christ does not *have* the truth but rather **He is the Truth.**
