The Lord said to Elijah: "Go, you are to anoint Elisha, son of Shaphat of Abel Meholah, as prophet to succeed you." Leaving there, Elijah came on Elisha, son of Shaphat as he was plowing behind twelve yoke of oxen; he himself being with the twelfth. Elijah passed near to him and threw his cloak over him. **Second Reading: Galatians 5:1, 13-18.**

When Christ freed us, he meant us to remain free. Stand firm, therefore, and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery. My brothers, you were called, as you know, to liberty; but be careful, or this liberty will provide an opening for self-indulgence. Serve one another, rather, in works of love, since the whole of the Law is summarised in a single command: Love your neighbour as yourself. 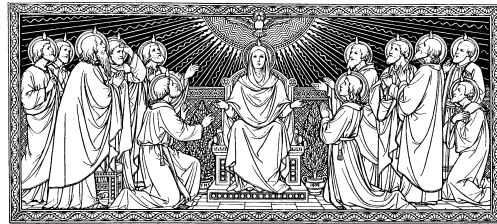

**Catholic Confirmation**

CCC1298-1302: Confirmation begins with the renewal of baptismal promises and the profession of faith by the confirmands. The bishop extends his hands over the whole group of the confirmands. Since the time of the apostles, this gesture has signified the gift of the Spirit. Then the sacrament of Confirmation is conferred through the anointing with chrism on the forehead with the words: 'Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit.' The effects are: it roots us more deeply in the divine filiation; it unites us more firmly to Christ; it increases the gifts of the Holy Spirit in us; it renders our bond with the Church more perfect; it gives us a special strength of the Holy Spirit to spread and defend the faith by word and action as true witnesses of Christ, to confess the name of Christ boldly, and never to be ashamed of the Cross.

Old Testament Prophets such as Elisha and Elijah were sent by God to teach His people. Today's teachers are the Bishops of the Church. Also, every home, as a domestic Church, has its own in-built teachers, they are parents. We are obliged to obey them. One should not make excuses for not being compliant. Parents are the best teachers of their children in the ways of Faith. God's will, however, overrides parental obligation. Jesus said: "*But you, go*

*and proclaim the kingdom of God."* When actual graces are given God expects us to act, and to use those graces. Many souls desire to do God's will but they lack commitment and are filled with excuses.



■ **What is Actual Grace?**

Grace is divided into two broad categories sanctifying grace and actual grace. The Catechism of the Church [CCC 2000] says that Sanctifying grace is an habitual gift, a stable and supernatural disposition that perfects the soul itself to enable it to live with God, to act by his love. Without this grace in our soul at death we cannot be saved. Actual grace, however, refers to God's interventions, whether at the beginning of conversion or in the course of the work of sanctification. We are in need of grace to help us grasp the truths of faith, to guide our steps, which inspire godly thoughts that result in godly actions.
