


THE SINS OF THE WORLD

Informed of this, Emperor Diocletian commanded Sebastian to offer sacrifice to the pagan gods, but he refused. He was then bound to a stake and shot by archers. Finding him half dead, Irene, a widow nursed him back to health. Sebastian was now determined to declare his faith openly. When he saw the emperor, he fearlessly rebuked him for persecuting the Christians. Startled by Sebastian's appearance, the emperor ordered him to be seized and beaten to death with clubs and his body thrown into the sewers. The traditional date of martyrdom is 287.
