First Reading: Jeremiah 20: 10-13

Jeremiah said: I hear so many disparaging me, "Terror from every side!" Denounce him! Let us denounce him! All those who used to be my friends watched for my downfall, 'Perhaps he will be seduced into error. Then we will master him and take our revenge!' But the Lord is at my side, a mighty hero; my opponents will stumble, mastered, confounded by their failure; everlasting, unforgettable disgrace will be theirs. But you, O Lord of Hosts, you who probe with justice, who scrutinise the loins and heart, let me see the vengeance you will take on them, for I have committed my cause to you. Second Reading: Romans 5: 12-15

Sin entered the world through one man, and through sin death, and thus death has spread through the whole human race because everyone has sinned. Sin existed in the world long before the Law was given. There was no law and so no one could be accused of the sin of 'law-breaking', yet death reigned over all from Adam to Moses, even though their sin, unlike that of Adam, was not a matter of breaking a law. Adam prefigured the One to come, but the gift

itself considerably outweighed the fall. If it is certain that through one man's fall so many died, it is even more certain that divine grace, coming through the one man, Jesus Christ, came to so many as an abundant free gift.

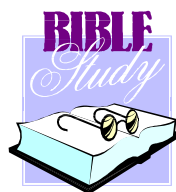
BIBLE matters in the MASS

Some words of the Mass: We often say the Hebrew word *Amen* which means: Yes, it's true e.g. at Communion the priest says: 'The Body of Christ' - we reply with 'Amen!' In Greek *Kyrie* means Lord and the Greek word *Eucharist* means thanksgiving. Did you know that the *First Eucharistic Prayer* or Roman Canon dates back to the 4th Century while the *Second Eucharistic Prayer* is even more ancient?

■ *Question:* Where are the words *holy, holy, holy* in the Bible?

Answer: In three places:

(1) "*Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts! they cried one to another. All the earth is filled with His glory!*" Is 6:3. (2) "*Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!*" Mk 12:9-10. (3). They never stop singing: "*Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty.*" Rev. 4:8.



The Difference

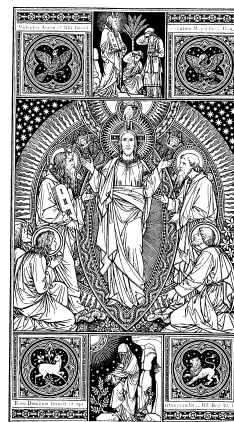
I got up early one morning
