But if he refuses to listen to these, report it to the community; and if he refuses to listen to the community, treat him like a pagan or a tax collector. 'I tell you solemnly, whatever you bind on earth shall be considered bound in heaven; whatever you loose on earth shall be considered loosed in heaven. 'I tell you solemnly once again, if two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them.'

Also people correct us on matters of health and we think nothing of it, indeed, sometimes we are grateful. So why not correct somebody in matters that concern their soul and salvation.

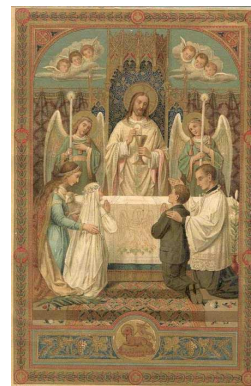
It is not necessarily judgmental to correct another for what they have actually done - the media does so! Provided we do not judge WHY they acted in a particular manner we are not being judgmental.

1. Correct the individual kindly in private.
2. If they pay no attention take one or two others with you to substantiate the claim.
3. If they still pay no attention then report them to the Church, Police or other authority, so that they are made to correct their behaviour.
