'Give unto Ceasar' refers to the Fourth Commandment: Honour your mother



dedicated to their daughter at Lisieux in France. The first parents of a saint to be beatified, they are the first spouses in the history of the Church to be proposed for sainthood as a couple and the second to be beatified together. They taught the faith to their children and in particular the youngest daughter, Thérèse, now a doctor of the Church. Zélie and Louis were not declared "blessed" because of Thérèse. She became a saint because of them.
