# TWO GREAT COMMANDMENTS LOVE GOD + LOVE OTHERS

Among the Pharisees, there existed much discussion about which one of the 613 laws of the Mizvot was the most important. Jesus not wanting to enter into their petty human debates reminds them of God's Law - the Ten Commandments. It consists of two sections: three laws for God and seven for us. Jesus summarized them into two: love of God and love of others. These laws are what we call the Natural Moral Law. This is the same law that is written on our consciences and by it we shall be judged. Respect for others and their things, as well as their good name



embraces many of these divine precepts that pertain to us. We are called to follow Christ in this manner, by our words and actions in conformity with His divine Will. The first three commandments, however, refer to God, His Name and divine Worship - that is, attending Holy Mass. To be a faithful Catholic we need to keep the **Precepts of the Church** CCC 2041:

Mass on Sunday & Holy Days (e.g Christmas, Assumption); Receive Holy Communion at least once a year; Confession of mortal sins at least once a year; Penance on Fridays and fasting (e.g. Lent); Support the parish (e.g. collections, d.deposit);

When we don't worship God we end up giving honour to something or someone which absorbs our attention and time. It gradually becomes an idol though we

don't think of it as such. Too many Australians spend an inordinate amount of time worshipping a game of sport instead of God!





# His Sacrifice of the Cross was not to be forgotten, so He said:

"Do <u>this</u> in remembrance of me!"

It was a command to the Apostles, who in turn would command priests to do this... But what is the this?

- Is it to celebrate a Last Supper meal as a memorial?
- Is it to share a banquet and think about His command that: "We should love one another..."?

It means to offer His Sacrifice: *The Pope teaches us*: "Jesus did not simply state that what he was giving them to eat and drink was his body and his blood; he also expressed its sacrificial meaning and made sacramentally present His Sacrifice which would soon be offered on the Cross for the salvation of all. The Mass is at the same time, and inseparably, the sacrificial memorial in which the sacrifice of the Cross is perpetuated."

All Saints Day is a surprisingly old feast. It arose out of the Christian tradition of celebrating the martyrdom of saints on the anniversary of their deaths. Pope Gregory IV (827-844) extended the feast to the entire Church and ordered it to be celebrated on November 1st.
