


## Second Reading: 1 John 4: 7-10

# **ACTS follows** the GOSPELS

The Gospel was oral long before it was written. The word Gospel is old English for God + spell. The Anglo-Saxon word spellein meaning to tell: God's telling or story. The teachings of our salvation from Jesus Christ were preached and taught before they were ever written down. The first book after the four Gospels is called the Acts of the Apostles written about 63 AD by Saint Luke, the author of the third Gospel who was not an Apostle and may have never seen Jesus. So what he learnt about Jesus was from oral or preached tradition. His Acts is an historical book recording the birth and expansion of the Church [Acts means the actions and words of the Apostles. It covers a period of thirty-five years, from the Ascension of the Lord unto St Paul's imprisonment in Rome. For that reason it is filled with Catholic gems and insights worthy of our attention.
